<b>A little history of LaBelle from: Bob <a href="mailto:rlsharp@pacificovertures.com">rlsharp@pacificovertures.com</a></b>
<b>Bob's mother's uncle (Moses Harrison) Harry Lipes; had a hardware store in LaBelle.</b>
<b>Bob's grandfather John William Sharp (up to 1919 had the store six miles of LaBelle that gave the name Sharpburg to the corner that now going uphill to the east is Heartland Dairy ... which itself is my great grandfather Adolphus Fishback's old place).</b>
<b>Bob's great uncle Joseph Layfayette Sharp who was a prosperous farmer, longtime LaBelle school board member.</b>
<b>Bob's great uncle Robert Knight Sharp who died young from falling on a pitchfork out of the barn.</b>
<b>Bob's mother's father Dr. Samuel Ernest Wallace, LaBelle's dentist from the turn of the century until 1943; stone deaf from his 20s (his form of anethesia... he couldn't hear complaints).</b>
<b>Bob's mother's mother, Willa Lipes Wallace; a local beauty from Deerridge who thought herself far too grand for a small town.</b>
